HOW THE PROGRAMME WORKS...

The Graduate programme is a fixed term employment program.

- 3 years fixed term after completion of SIT Pre-Trade Course (Predominately Invercargill & Gore Apprentices)
- 4 years fixed term straight into an apprenticeship from school/work, (Predominately Queenstown & Alexandra Apprentices)

GWD provides high quality on-job training and support for the apprentice throughout.

Opportunity for the apprentice to complete additional Toyota and Holden Franchise Training.

Training fees are reimbursed if apprentice achieves yearly credit targets set by MITO.

At the end of the fixed term, GWD Motor Group will endeavour to provide permanent full time employment if a position is available. In the unlikely event a position is not available, GWD will work with local MTA members to find suitable employment for the graduate.



INDUSTRY PARTNERSHIPS

We work alongside numerous industry partners to support the apprentice through their training, and provide additional opportunities throughout.

We prefer our apprentice's to have completed a SIT pre-trade course prior to commencing their apprenticeship (applicable to apprentices in Southland)



Our apprentice's undertake their apprenticeship training with MITO, who are the National Industry Standard Setting body for the Motor Trade.
